BRUBAKER, Henry 21 Aug 1862

Henry, age 30, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private. He was reduced from Corporal 10 March 1863 at his own request; captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, LA; mustered out 6 July 1865 at Camp Chase, OH.
