GRANT, Bryant 12 Sept 1862 Bryan GRANT

Bryant, age not given, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 263, as a 1st Lieut. There is nothing in the remarks section of the Roster book. In a letter to the Wooster Republican for 27 Nov 1862 James Taylor stated: "Our 1st Lieutenant Bryan Grant, has not been with the regiment since we left Camp Mansfield, nor have we heard from him, suppose he is unable to join the regiment."

So, Bryan may never have served.

"The following named officers having been reported at the Headquarters of the Army, for the offences [sic] hereinafter specified, are hereby notified that they will stand dismissed from the service of the United States, unless within (15) fifteen days from this date they appear before the Commission, in session in this city, of which Brigadier General Ricketts is President, and make satisfactory defence [sic] to the charges against them."

......included was First Lieutenant Bryant Grant, co. H, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio volunteers.

According to one researcher, Bryan Grant was the son of Isaac Travis Grant and Maria Alexander of New York state. His birth is given as 8 Mar 1833 in Schaghticoke, [Rensselaer Co] New York. They list four children for Bryan and Edith: Cora (1858), Wallace (1861), Cora Lena (1864), and Bertha Adeline (1868). **Edith died 22 Sep 1878** and Bryant married Mary Ann Gillespie on 8 Dec 1880 and had one child Herbert Alexander Grant in 1884.
