

## Company H, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

GRUBAUGH, John H \* 22 Aug 1862

John Henry GRUBAUGH

John, age 23, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private. John died 20 Ap 1863 at Smith's Landing, LA. Unfortunately, the Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book does not tell where John Grubaugh is buried. It is left blank, just saying that he died at Smith's Landing, La on 20 Ap 1863.

Mother: Elizabeth RIBLET

Birth: 8 Sep 1840 Richland Co OH

Marriage: Majora Shaffer, Holmes Co OH, 10 Aug. 1861

Death: 20 Apr 1863, Smith's Landing, LA [in the vicinity of Young's Point]

Cemetery: unknown

US Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Mistakenly lists John as John H. SCRUBAUGH, Pvt, Co A 120th OH, died 19 Apr 1863 at regimental hospital of acute dysentery. Byron Stanton, regimental surgeon.

Have not found on Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Not on National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962

Pension listing for John H. Grubaugh: His widow Margaret filed for a pension on 4 Sep 1863, Application 32118, Certificate 35852. A filing was made for a minor on 25 May 1867, Application 145612, Certificate 101306 with the guardian as William L. Walker.

Minor child Andrew G. GRUBAUGH was born 22 November 1861 at Perry?, Ashland Co OH. [see pension papers below]

In July 1863 widow Margery was living in Richland Co OH, post office Loudonville, age 22. [see pension papers below]

Widow, Family Search, Indiana, Marriages, 1811-1959: Margery GRUBAUGH married John LEWIS 18 July 1866 at Marshall Co IN. By Levi Holloway, J.P.

1870 Census, Bourbon corporation, Marshall Co IN, Dwelling 19, Family 19: Mag LEWIS, age 30 OH, keeping house of ill fame; Jackson LEWIS, age 8 OH. [This is Margery and son Andrew Jackson GRUBAUGH.]

1880 Census, Linnville, Bowling Green Twp, Licking Co OH, Dwelling 6, Family 7: M.V.B. GARRISON, age 40 OH, carpenter, parents born OH; Maggie, wife, age 40 OH, parents born VA; Jackson GOOBACK [? GRUBAUGH], step son, age 17 OH, works on farm, parents born OH. [Martin, MVB, died 7 Apr 1922 at Licking Co, age 81. Sgt, Co E 185th OVI His wife then was Elizabeth, Lizzie, whose maiden name was BLIZZARD.]

[Maggie GARRISON](#) died 27 Sep 1892 and is buried in Linnville Cemetery, Licking Co OH.

son, Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: [Andrew Jackson GRUBAUGH](#) died 7 Sep 1938 at Bowling Green, Licking Co OH. Age 76, 9m, 16dys. Accident: fell backward striking his head on a cement floor. Married. Born OH.

Farmer. Born 22 Nov 1861 in OH. Burial Fairmount Cemetery. Father John H. GRUBAUGH. Mother Margaret SHAFFER. Wife: Nancy Arvilla [FRUSH] GRUBAUGH. Informant, Ralph GRUBAUGH of Thornville Rd.

*There is a marriage for a John H. Grubaugh and Majora Shaffer in Holmes county OH on 10 Aug. 1861.]*

John Henry and Marjory Shaffer did have a son. He was Andrew Jackson Grubaugh, b.11-22-1861; d.9-7-1938. As far as I know, this is the only child they had. Andrew married in Licking County, Ohio, and had a family.

John Henry, as far as I know, only lived in Richland County before he entered military service. I have no record what his occupation was before the war. His wife Marjory Shaffer is a bit of a mystery in my data, I have her birth as 1840, and an unsure death date of about 1866. The verbal history is that she died when son Andrew was about 5 years old - hence the "about 1866" date for her death.

Pension at fold3.com :

John H. GRUBAUGH, Co H 120th OH Inf: died at Smith's Plantation in hospital 18/20 Apr 1863 of typho malarial fever. Became ill 10 Apr 1863 in LA. Another paper says he died at Richmond, LA. He enrolled in the military in Richland Co OH.

William L. WALKER: Guardian's residence was Hardin Co OH, post office Kenton, OH. Payments to him started 19 July 1866, the day after the widow remarried.

John H. GRUBAUGH married Margery SHAFFER 10 Aug 1861, by Emanuel Ridle, J.P., at Holmes Co OH.

In July 1863 widow Margery was living in Richland Co OH, post office Loudonville, age 22.

Minor child Andrew G. GRUBAUGH was born 22 November 1861 at Perry?, Ashland Co OH. Mary and Amada BARTLETT were present when Andrew was born.

Widow Margery GRUBAUGH remarried 18 July 1866 to John LEWIS, at Marshall Co IN, by Levi Holloway, J.P.
