HARBAUGH, Horace A. 14 Oct 1862 Horace B HARBAUGH  
Horace, age 34, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 264, as a Private. Horace was transferred to Co. K, 114th OVI 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Company E of the 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Horace Burton Harbaugh was born in Erie County PA 15 Nov 1827. His parents were Richard HARBAUGH and Charlotte FIDLER. Horace had a brother Edwin Richard. It appears from the 1850 census that Charlotte and son Edwin were living in Williams County OH. Horace married his first wife Elizabeth FIDLER in Mercer county OH in 1848. Their children were Amy Ellen, Horace Greeley, Charles Wesley, Elizabeth, Richard Erwin, Joshua F. (Jesse), Edwin Secord, and Henry Fidler. All these children were born before Horace volunteered for the war. His first wife died in 1863 while Horace was away at war. After the war he married Deborah L. WHITE in Montpelier, Williams Co Oh 19 Ap 1866. They had 3 children: Rebecca Charlotte (1867) and Emaline and Eveline (1868). Horace died 8 Dec 1869 in Williams County OH. Deborah later moved to Isabella Co MI where she owned property.

Horace HARBAUGH married Elizabeth FIDLER, Mercer Co OH, 1848.

1850 Census, Liberty Twp, Mercer Co OH, Dwelling 2, Family 2: Harris ARBAUGH, age 23 PA, farmer; Eliz, age 26 PA; Westley LONG, age 5 OH; Hannah M LONG, age 3 OH; Anna Ellen ARBAUGH, age one OH.

1860 Census, Liberty Twp, Mercer County, OH, page 362: H B HARBAUGH, age 33 PA, farmer; Elizabeth, age 35 PA; Ellen, age 11 OH; Horace, age 9 OH; Charles, age 7 OH; Elizabeth, age 6 OH; Richard J, age 5 OH; Josiah, age 3 OH; H M LONG, age 13 OH; Wesley LONG, age 15 OH, farm hand.

[Soldier's second wife with her first husband: In 1860, Jesse and Deborah WILLIAMS are listed with children Joseph H, age 6, and Charles E, age 1, in Florence Twp, Williams Co OH. Deborah WHITE married Jesse WILLIAMS in 1852 in Williams Co OH. ]

Family Search, Ohio, Marriages, 1800-1958: Horace HARBAUGH married Deborah L. WILLIAMS 19 Apr 1866 at Williams Co OH.

1870 Census, Florence, Williams Co OH, Dwelling 275, Family 275: Deborah HARBAUGH, age 37 PA; Charles, age 17 OH; Elizabeth, age 15 OH; Rebecca, age 3 OH; Emiline, age 2 OH; Evaline, age 2 OH; Charles WILLIAMS, age 11 OH.

1880 Census, Florence, Williams Co OH, Dwelling 303, Family 321: B L HARBAUGH, age 46 PA, parents born PA; Charles E, son, age 21 OH, farm laborer, parents born PA; Rebecca C, daughter, age 12 OH; Emeline, daughter, age 11 OH; Evaline, daughter, age 11 OH.

1900 Census, Rolland Twp, Isabella Co MI, Dwelling 225, Family 232: Deborah L HARBAUGH, age 67 PA, born Dec 1833 farmer, widowed, 6 children/5 still living, parents born PA; Charles E WILLIAMS, son, age 40 OH, born Dec 1859, single, farmer, father born OH, mother born PA; Prudence WILLIAMS, daughter, age 37 OH, single? or divorced?, born Aug 1862, father born OH, mother born PA. [Note: in 1910 Prudence was living with Joseph H, age 55 OH, and Minerva H WILLIAMS and family in Rolland Twp, Isabella Co MI, and is listed as Joseph's sister. ]

Deborah may have died between 1900 and 1910 but I haven't found a record.
