LONG, Davidson 19 Aug 1862 Davison LONG
Davidson, age 25, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265, as a Private. He was wounded 11 Jan 1863 in the battle of Arkansas Post, Ark.; also wounded in the battle of Jackson Miss.; he was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, LA; he was mustered out 6 July 1865 at Camp Chase, OH.

Davison LONG, born in 1837, was the son of James LONG and Susannah KNIGHT. He had five sisters: Lovina, Delilah, Christina, Venus and Nancy. He had five brothers: John, Andrew, Polston, Quinby, and Harrison. At some time after he married he moved to Lucas County OH. He was still alive in 1900.

More from Nancy: Davison and family moved to Vanburen, Lagrange, Indiana around 1877.

Father James died 1848. [Fountain Hill Cemetery](#), Wayne Co OH.

1850 Census, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 329, Family 337: Adam LONG, age 27 PA, farmer; Delila, age 23 OH; Susannah, age 5 OH; John W., age 4 OH; Mary E, age 3 OH; William H, age 3 months OH; Poulson LONG, age 18 OH, farmer; David, age 12 OH. [Next door is Andrew LONG, age 26 OH, farmer; Elizabeth, age 22 OH.]

Wayne County Probate Court record: Davison LONG married Mary J. CRUMMEL 16 Oct 1858 in Wayne County OH.

1860 Monroe Twp, Allen Co, IN, page 436: Davidson LONG, age 23 OH, laborer living with the George and Mary MYERS family. Next door are Andrew LONG, age 37 OH, farmer; Elizabeth, age 28 PA; Susan, age 10 OH; Mary, age 8 OH; Levina, age 6 OH; John, age 4 OH; David, age 2 OH.

Mother Susanna at HeritageQuest, the scan is not readable, but HQ has interpreted it as:

1860 Census, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH, family 853: Susanna LONG, age 64 PA; Harrison LONG, age 20 OH.

1870 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 172, dated 9 June: Davidson LONG, age 32 OH, engineer on mill; Mary J, age 26 OH; Davidson, age 7 OH; Joseph W, age 3 OH; Moncrief, age 2 OH; Mary Eliza, age 4 months OH, born in Feb. Also living there was John GROW, age 12 OH [at school].

1870 Census, Green Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 222, dated 5 Aug: Davidson LONG, age 32 OH, farm laborer; Mary J, age 27 OH; Davidson, age 9 OH; William J, age 6 OH; Montcrif, age 3 OH; Mary E, age 3 months OH, born in May?; Charles JOHNS, age 19 OH, teamster; Susan LONG, age 75 PA, retired.

Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997, at Family Search: Susan LONG died 11 Feb 1876 at Green Twp, Wayne Co OH, age 82, born <1794>, born Greene, PA, widow.

Mother Susanna is buried next to father James at [Fountain Hill Cemetery](#), Wayne Co OH.

1880 Census, Van Buren, Lagrange County, IN, page 305: Davison LONG, age 42 OH, day laborer, parents born PA; Mary I, wife, age 37 OH, parents born PA; Davison, son, age 17 OH, works at farm; Joseph W, son, age 13 OH, works at farm; Moncreath, son, age 11 OH; Mary E, daughter, age 9 OH; Elmore E, son, age 7 OH; Estella M, daughter, age 3 IN.

1900 Census, 12th Ward, Toledo, Lucas County OH, page 192: Davison LONG, age 66 OH, born ?? 1833, married 39 yrs, parents born PA, painter; Mary J, wife, age 54 OH, born Apr?? 1845, 11 children/6 still living, married 39 yrs, parents born PA; Davis, son, age 37 OH, born ?Aug 1862, married 13 yrs, dock laborer; Alvin, son, age 11 [can't be right] OH, born ?? 1883, parents born OH; Edward, grandson, age 12 OH, born ? 1888; Trevoar NELSON, grandson, age 11 MI, born May 1889, father born MI, mother born OH.

Family Search, Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: Davidson LONG died 6 Oct 1904 at Sandusky, OH. Age 71. Born 1833. Civil War Veteran. Burial Toledo, OH.

Wife's death record: Mary J. LONG died 29 Jan 1912 at Toledo, Lucas Co OH. Age 68. Born 1844 in OH. Widowed. Father Samuel CRUMMEL born OH. Mother born OH. Burial Forest Cemetery.

Sons of Union Veterans: Burial Woodlawn Cemetery, West Central Ave, Toledo, Toledo Twp, Lucas County, OH.

Son's Death record in Ohio: File #51749, Elmer LONG died 28 Aug 1918 at Tuberculosis Hospital, Toledo, Lucas County OH. Single. Born 24 Feb 1873 in OH. Iron worker. Father Davidson LONG. Mother Mary CRUMMELL. Burial Forest Cemetery.

Brother's Death Record in Ohio: File 72619, Harrson LONG died 9 Nov 1920 at Green Twp, Wayne co OH where he had lived his entire life. Married. Retired farmer. Age 81 yrs, 5 m, 26 dys. Born 13 May 1839, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH. Father James LONG, born PA. Mother Susan KNIGHT, born PA. Informant William JONES of Orrville, OH RFD. Burial Crown Hill, Orrville, OH.

Brother Polson LONG died in 1901 in Indiana. [He served as a Private in Co F 147th Indiana Inf.](#) He had been in the [National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers](#) in Marion, IN. Born 1837.
