Perry, no age given, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265, as a Private. He was listed as a Corporal, but he never mustered.

[Wayne Co Probate Court record: John MANLY married Mary POULSON on 19 Feb 1838 at Wayne Co OH.]
