

Company H, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

MOWRY, Christian * 16 Aug 1862

Christian, age 22, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265, as a Private.

Christian **died** 12 March 1863 at Memphis, TN. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book states that Christian Mowry is buried in the Mississippi River Cemetery at Memphis TN. [Not listed there.]

Death: 12 March 1863 at Memphis, TN

Cemetery: Mississippi River Cemetery at Memphis TN [Not on Nationwide Gravesite Locator, Dept of Veterans Affairs.] Probably buried there as an unknown.
