MYERS, Joseph 13 Aug 1862
Joseph, age 24, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 263 as a 1st Sergeant. He was appointed from Sergeant on 1 Jan 1864. He was **captured** 3 May 1864, near Snaggy Point, on Red River, LA. He was mustered out 6 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio. In the Wooster Republican, 29 Jan 1863: At No. 3 Hospital, Adam's Block, Memphis, TN: Listed Joseph Myers, company H, 120th. No reason given.

1850 Census, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH: Joseph and Susanna Myers; Louisa (23), Maria (21), Francis W. (Male age 19), John (16), William P.[see below] (14), Joseph (13), Menno S.[see below], age 6, and Susan E. (4). Everyone in the family was born in PA.

Family Search, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Joseph Myers Jr. married Mary J. MYLAR 21 Jun 1866 in Wayne County OH, by Andrew Virtue, Minister of the Gospel.
It would seem that Mary J Mylar may be the sister of Isaac Mylar of this list who also lived in Missouri after the war. See Isaac Mylar below.

1880 Census, Series T9 Roll 677, Lincoln Twp, Caldwell Co MO, page 402: Joseph MYERS, age 42 PA, surveyor, parents born PA; Mary J, wife, age 41 OH, parents born PA; Sada, daughter, age 13 OH; Mariah, daughter, age 10 MO; Wm W LESTER?, age 22 IN.

Not found in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

Mary J. Mylar Myers died 2 May 1929. [Nina Bledsoe Rippee contributed the newspaper death notice.]

Mrs. Mary J. Myers Is Dead.
Mrs. Mary J. Myers, 90 years old, died early today at the home of her daughter, Mrs. H. C. Austin, 5829 Kenwood avenue. Mrs. Myers came to Kansas City thirteen years ago from Laclede, Mo., the home town of John J. Pershing. Mrs. Myers was a personal friend of General Pershing. Mrs. Myers lived in Laclede and Brookfield, Mo., until she came to Kansas City. Funeral services will be held at 9 o'clock Saturday at the Newcomer chapel, Robert Gillham road and the Paseo. Burial will be in Brookfield.

Austin, age 55 OH, married, father born NY, mother born OH, industrial teacher; Sadie S. wife, age 52 OH, father born Pa, mother born OH; Gladys, daughter, age 20 MO, single, parents born OH, office work in wholesale dry goods company; Edith, daughter, age 15 Mo, parents born OH; Mary J. Myers, mother in law, age 80 OH, widow, father born VA, mother born OH.
