Benjamin, age 22, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 263 as a Sergeant. He was captured at Snaggy Point on Red River, LA 3 May 1864.

From <u>Hardesty's</u>: Benjamin M. Norris enlisted at Smithville. After his capture at Snaggy Point he was held at Camp Ford for 13 months.

There are no discharge papers in Wayne County for Benjamin Norris.

Benjamin M. Norris, aged 69 years, died at his home in Orrville Tuesday night from heart trouble. He was very well known throughout the eastern part of the county. Mr. Norris was born at Smithville and when a young man he entered the Union army and took part in a number of battles during the civil war. After the strife was over he returned to Smithville where he lived until about 15 years ago when he started a greenhouse at Orrville. His brother is now postmaster at Smithville. His wife and one daughter survive. Funeral services Friday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock.

Benj. M. Norris, age 69 years, for some years postmaster at Smithville, died Tuesday afternoon at his home in Orrville. Mr. Norris has been in ill health for some months. Mr. Norris was a soldier during the rebellion and a man who was widely known over the county. He is survived by Mrs. Norris and one daughter, Mrs. Perry Taggart of Massillon. The funeral was held Friday, interment in Orrville cemetery.
