SCHINDLER, William \* 1 Sept 1862  
William, age 25, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265, as a Private. William died 23 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, LA. [Died of disease]  
The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book lists William Schindler as being buried in Vicksburg, Mississippi. But I don't find him on the list at Interment.com at the National Cemetery. His body may have been moved to Richland Co OH.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: William SCHINDLER, Private, Co H 120th OH Inf. died 23 Feb 1863 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: typo mal febris.

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Not found in Pension Index.

1850 Census, Washington Twp, Richland Co OH: Dwelling 145, Family 145: Christoph CHINDLER, age 49 Germany, farmer; Hannah, age 42 Germany; Christian, age 19 Germany; Laura, age 17 Germany; William, age 13 Germany; Colheim [male], age 10 Germany; John, age 3 Germany. [Researcher Suzie Ferguson says that Colheim is a mistake....it should have been Katharine, age 10, a girl. "Christian (1801-1875) and Hannah Onheiser Schindler (1808-1888) had five children: Christian (1829-1911), Laura, my [Suzie's] gg grandmother (1833-1910), Wilhelm-William (1837-1863), Katharine (1839-1924), and John (1847-1939). They immigrated to Quebec and went to Missouri in August, 1847. In the spring of 1848 they came to Richland County."]

Ohio, County Marriages: Lara SCHENDLER married Christian MINGERT, 10 Mar 1853, Richland Co OH.

1860 Census, Washington Twp, Richland County, OH, page 234: William SHINGER, age 23 OH, laborer. He is living with the John and Unity BROWN family.

Mother next door, Dwelling 94, Family 97: Hanah SHINDLER, age 73 Germany, parents born Germany.

Brother's Ohio Death record: John SCHINDLER died 13 Mar 1939 at Lexington Village, Richland Co OH. Age 92 yrs, 2 mths, 8 dys. Widowed. Farmer. Born 5 Jan 1847, Beveria [sic] Germany. Burial at Lexington. Father Christifer SCHINDLER, born Germany. Mother Hanna ONHOUSER, born Germany. Spouse Louisa STRATER.
