

## Company H, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

STUTZMAN, Ezra\* 13 Aug 1862

Ezra, age 23, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265 as a Private. He **died** 6 Jan 1863 at Memphis TN. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster Book states that Ezra Stutzman is buried at Mississippi River Cemetery in Memphis TN.

In the Wooster Republican, published 29 Jan 1863, Ezra Stutzman of the 120th was listed as discharged from Foundry Hospital in Memphis TN. [News often came late.]

Ezra was from Green Twp. when he entered the war.

Father: Henry STUTZMAN

Mother: Catherine MILLER

Birth: 21 Mar 1839, Wayne Co OH

Marriage: Single

Death: 5 or 6 Jan 1863, Memphis TN

Cemetery: Mississippi River Cemetery in Memphis, Shelby Co, TN [Memphis National Cemetery] [Not listed. Probably buried there as an unknown.]

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Ezra STUTZMAN, Private, Co H 120th OH Inf., died 8 Jan 1863 at General Hospital No 2 Memphis, TN. Cause: paralysis.

Not on National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962.

Not on Pension Index.

1850 Census, Green Township, Wayne County OH : Henry STUTZMAN, PA, farmer; Jeremiah age 21 OH; Susanna age 19 OH; Daniel age 17 OH; Elizabeth age 15 OH; Christian, age 13 OH; Ezra, age 11 OH; Aaron age 9 OH; Anne age 6 OH; Henry age 4 OH; Christena WHISLER age 35.

1860 Census, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 47: Henry STUTZMAN, age 56 PA, farmer; Christina, age 46 PA; Ezra, age 21 OH; Aaron, age 19 OH; Ann, age 17 OH; Henry, age 14 OH.

This book verifies that Ezra STUTZMAN who died single in the Civil War was the son of Henry STUTZMAN and Catherine MILLER. Ezra was born 21 Mar 1839 in Wayne County OH. It lists his death date as 5 Jan 1863. His mother died in 1846. His siblings listed in the book are the same as the ones listed in the census.
