Two Records for Headstones Provided for Deceased Union Civil War

Veterans, 1879-1903.

TAYLOR, Thomas B. 10 Oct 1862

Thomas, age 27, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265, as a Private. He was discharged on 4 July 1863 on a Surgeon's certificate of disability. ???Thomas Benton TAYLOR???

Pension Index, on two separate cards: Thomas B TAYLOR, H 120th OH Inf. Invalid applied 9 Nov 1865, Application 95229, Certificate 103036. Widow, Sarah M TAYLOR, applied 30 Dec 1886, Application 348534, Certificate 232376, filed in OH.

Here is a connection between Thomas B TAYLOR and Capt. James B. TAYLOR, also of Company H. In 1870, Thomas' future wife, Sarah DORLAND was living with James and Elizabeth TAYLOR who were Capt. James TAYLOR's parents.

1870 Census Salt Creek, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 88, Family 86: James TAYLOR, age 67 E. VA, attorney at law; Elizabeth, age 69 E. VA, retired lady; Sarah DORLAND, age 23 OH, domestic servant. Was Thomas B the son of James B and Elizabeth who was named Benton in the 1850 Census? He was the right age.

1850 Census, Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 119, Family 121: James TAYLOR, age 48 VA, lawyer; Elisabeth, age 50 VA; John, age 23 OH, student: Margaret, age 19 OH; **Benton, age 16 OH <b 1834>**; Bruce, age 14 OH; James, age 10 OH; Mary A SAPP, age 20 PA.

1860 Census, Prairie, Holmes County, OH, page 377: Thos B TAYLOR, age 26 OH, blacksmith; Elizabeth, age 27 OH; Mary A MISMORE?, age 6 OH.

1870 Census, Salt Creek, Wayne County, OH, page 319: Thomas TAYLOR, age 35 OH, blacksmith; Elizabeth, age 37 OH; Emma E LOUST, age 8 OH.

Is this [Elizabeth](#), wife of Thomas who died 28 Jan 1872 and is buried at Moreland Cemetery which is in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co OH?

Ohio Marriages: T. B. TAYLOR married Sarah M. DORLAND, 8 Oct 1872, Holmes Co OH.

Is this the daughter of Thomas and Sarah? I can't see the original to check the initials J. B. Omia Luella TAYLOR, born 7 Nov 1873 at Wayne Co OH, Father J. B. TAYLOR. Mother Sarah May DORLAND. Family Search I can't find any further record.

1880 Census, have not found

Wayne County Death Records: Thomas V. TAYLOR died 30 Aug 1886 at Dalton, Wayne Co OH. Birthplace, Fredricksburg, Wayne Co OH. Blacksmith. Married. Age 52.

1890 Special Soldiers Schedule: Sugar Creek, Wayne County, OH: Sarah M, widow of Thomas B TAYLOR, private, Co H 120th Ohio. Post Office Dalton. He died Aug 1886.
