VIENY, Jacob * 16 Aug 1862

Jacob, age 20, is listed in the Roster of Ohio Soldiers 1861-66 volume 8, page 265, as a Private.

Jacob **died** 24 Jan 1863 at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri. The Roll of Honor in the back of the Roster book states that Jacob Vieny is buried at Jefferson Barracks Cemetery in St. Louis Co. Missouri.

There is a Jacob Veney listed in the 1860 census for Wayne county OH on page 229 in Canaan Township. He was age 17, living with Henry and Margaret Swartz. He is listed as a farm laborer and was born in France.
