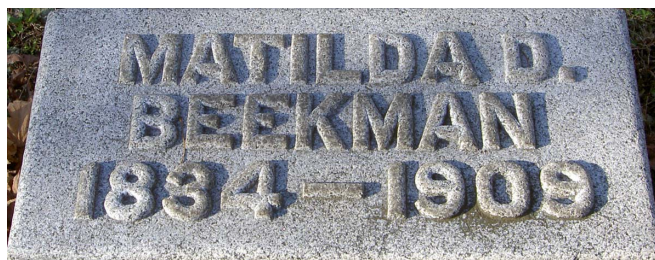

BEEKMAN, Abram D. 3 Sept 1862 Abram Derry BEEKMAN

Also listed at Soldiers and Sailors site as Abrams BEEKMAN.

Private Beekman was age 29 when he entered service. Promoted to Captain 3d Regiment Mississippi Volunteers, afterward designated as 53d Regiment U.S. Colored Troops, on 19 June 1863, from which resigned 5 Oct 1863.

1850 Census, Plymouth Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 222, Family 229: John W. BEEKMAN, age 28 NY, merchant; Betsey A., age 32 NY; Mary F., age 5 OH; William F, age 3 OH; Issac C., age 9 months OH; Stephen STARR, age 25 OH, clerk; Day BEEKMAN, age 16 NY, clerk.

Ohio Marriages: Abram D. BEEKMAN married Matilda DAY on 28 Oct 1855 at Huron OH.

1860 Census, New Haven Township, Huron county OH, page 109: A D BECKMAN age 27 NY, a salesman; Matilda, age 26 NJ; Jennie age 3 OH. [Note: Jennie married PRENTISS]

1870 Census, City of Mansfield, 1st Ward, Richland County OH, page 120: Abram BEAKMAN, age 35 NY, machine Agt?; Matilda, age 35 NJ; Jennie, age 12 OH.

1880 Census, Plymouth village, Huron Co OH, Dwelling 71, Family 79: Frank B. DAY, age 76 NJ, retired blacksmith, parents born NJ; Ruma B, wife, age 74 NY, parents born NY; Derry BEEKMAN, son in law, age 46 NY, parents born NY, life and fire insurance agent; Tildia, wife, age 45 NJ, father born NJ, mother born NY; Alma DAY, daughter in law, age 42 OH, father born CT, mother born NY; Lora DAY, daughter, age 13 OH, parents born OH; John DAY, son, age 10 OH, parents born OH.

[Richland \[Ohio\] Indigent Soldier Burials 1885-1896](#): A D BEEKMAN of Co I, 120th, place of death Plymouth, traveling salesman, died 29 Dec 1889.

Did not find on 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Plymouth Village, Plymouth Township, Richland County OH: Matilda BEEKMAN age 50 born Dec 1849 in OH, widow, 4 children 3 still living, father CT, mother VT, no occupation; Hattie, daughter, a tailoress, single, age 17, born Aug 1882 in OH, parents born in OH.

Sons of Union Veterans: Soldier buried Greenlawn Cemetery, state route 98, Plymouth, Richland County OH. Died 29 Dec 1889. Born 1833.
