BOOYER, William 2 Sept 1862 alternate spelling BOOZER
Private Booyer was age 24 when he entered service. Discharge 27 Dec 1862 on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.
Soldiers and Sailors site lists him as William BOOZER.

Father: Henry BOOZER

Mother: Sarah McEWEN

Birth: 1837 PA [Date Calculator: Birth would be 22 Oct 1837]

Marriage: probably single

Death: Springfield Township, 17 Feb 1869

Cemetery: [Springfield Cem](#), Springfield Twp, Richland Co OH, 31 yrs, 3 m 26 dys Stone spells his name BOOZER.

Can't find 1850.

1860 Census Springfield Township, Richland County OH: Henry BROZER or BRAZER age 63 born PA, a farmer; Sarah age 60 PA; James age 27 PA, farm hand; Wm age 23 PA; Margaret age 17 PA; Victor DICKSON age 15 OH. [Note: [Pleasant Hill Cem](#)/Rowalt

Cemetery, Springfield Twp, parents grave stone: Henry BOOZER 25 Jan 1798 - 19 Nov 1874; Sarah McEWEN, his wife, 26 Feb 1800 - 9 apr 1877]

Civil War Draft Registrations Records: William Boozer, 8th Congressional District, age 25 as of 1 July 1863. born about 1838 in PA, white, unmarried, farmer. Enumerated June 1863. Richland County OH. Formerly discharged from 120th OVI.

Parents in 1870 with the name spelled BOOZER: 1870 Census Springfield Township, Richland County OH: Henry BOOZER age 73 PA, a farmer; Sarah age 70 PA; Margiry or Margery age 24 PA. [Note: James A, age 29 was also listed.]

Hardesty's (Richland) has William BROGER listed in the Roll of Honor as being from Company I. He enlisted at Mansfield. It says that he died in Springfield Township on 17 Feb 1869.
