

## Company I, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

CHURCH, Alfred S. 11 Aug 1862

Private Alfred Church was age 21 when he entered service. Captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio. [Pension index shows he was also in Co D 32d OH. See below]

Father: William CHURCH

Mother: Margaret SCOTT

Birth: Aug 1840, OH

Marriage: Mary C. ????, divorced

Death: 5 Jan 1910, Leavenworth KS

Cemetery: Leavenworth National Cemetery, Leavenworth, KS, Section 27 Row 2 Site 21

Relationship: brother of Alonzo B. CHURCH, Co. I 120th OVI

Alfred S. CHURCH, died 5 Jan 1910. Buried at Leavenworth National Cemetery, Leavenworth, KS. It says he was also in the Spanish American War [One record has a start service date 21 Apr 1898. That would have been during the time that he was at United States National Home for Volunteer Soldiers, Leavenworth KS. But his burial record lists on Co I, 120 Ohio Inf.]

Pension index: Alfred S CHURCH, I 120th and D 32nd OH Inf. Invalid filed 22 Jul 1890, Application 819291, Certificate 1001807, filed in Kansas. Pension Card: Alfred died 1910. [Note: Alfred Church, age 21, enrolled 17 July 1861, is listed as enrolled in Co D 32nd OH Inf, but there are no comments listed about him. Perhaps he never left the state with that regiment.]

1850 Census, Springfield Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 591, Family 591: William CHURCH, age 56 NY, farmer; Eliza, age 25 NY; Clarissa, age 28 OH; Alonzo, age 19 OH, farmer; Alfred, age 9 OH; Margaret, age 7 OH. [Note: ?Parents, Richland County Probate Court record: William CHURCH married Margaret SCOTT on 16 Nov 1820 in Richland Co OH.]

1860 Springfield Township, Richland county OH: Alfet CHURCH is living with Alexander and Caroline MEANS. CHURCH is a farm hand, age 19 born OH.

Have not found 1870

1880 Census, Empire Gulch, Lake County, Colorado: A S CHURCH age 39 OH, railroad agent, parents born NY; Mary C CHURCH age 28 WI, parents born NY.

1900 Census Delaware Township, Lansing, Leavenworth, KS, National Military Home for Disabled: Alfred S CHURCH, age 59 born Aug 1840 in OH, looks like a D for divorced, assistant post master, parents born NY.

United States National Home for Volunteer Soldiers, Leavenworth KS: Alfred S. CHURCH Time and place of each enlistment Springfield Twp, OH, 11 Aug 1862 in the 120th OH Inf. and Tyler TX, 27 Nov 1864 in the 114th OH Inf. . Private. Prisoner of war nearly 13 months at Camp Ford Tyler Tex. Discharged at Tyler TX 27 Nov 1864, transferred to 114th. Discharged at Camp Chase OH, 7 July 1865. Kind and Degree of disability: Int. fever and rheumatism contracted at Kansas City MO. Protestant. Born OH. Age at admittance 48, 6 ft tall, fair complexion, dark eyes, dark hair; Telegraph operator. Residence subsequent to discharge Kansas City MO. Single. P. O address of nearest relative: Miss Jennie MEANS, Birmingham, Michigan. Date of admission [first] 20 Feb 1889, Co B. Permanent admission 16 July 1894. Died 5 Jan 1910, chronic interstitial nephritis. Location of grave and remarks: Section 27, Row 2, grave 3819; died at hospital 1:15 pm 5 Jan 1910. Funeral at 2:30 pm 6 Jan 1910. Mrs. Eva LORIMON, Box 58 Wintersett OH and Mrs. N. HALL (sister) Brent Creek MI notified. Rev. James M PAYNE chaplain.
