COLEMAN, Arthur* 11 Aug 1862

Private Arthur Coleman was age 18 when he entered service. He died 7 July 1863. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Shiloh, Tennessee, in section 6, grave 37.

Cemetery: Originally buried at Shiloh, Hardin Co, Tennessee, in section 6, grave 37 [Not listed at Shiloh National Military Park] He was reinterred at Jefferson Barracks, St. Louis Co MO, Sec 6 site 7579.

The record at US Department of Veterans Affairs gravesite locator lists the death of the soldier buried here as 7 July 1863.

Relationship: Is this soldier related to James Coleman of this same company? James Coleman had a grandson named Arthur, perhaps named for this soldier?

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Arthur COLEMAN, Pvt, Co A [incorrect] 120th OH Inf, died 7 Jul 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks MO. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960
