

Company I, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

ETZWILER, Samuel 25 Jan 1864 Samuel Henry Etwiler
Private Etwiler was age 30 when he entered service. Captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Richland County Probate Court Marriage Records: Samuel ETZWILER married Maria ARNOLD on 8 May 1858 in Richland County OH.

1860 Census Madison Township, Richland County OH: Sam'l ETZWILER age 27 born OH, laborer; Maria age 26 born OH; Ashford age 8 OH; Amanda age 2 OH.

Richland County Probate Court Marriage Records: Samuel ETZWILER married Emma SUTCH on 11 Nov 1867 in Richland County OH.

1870 Census Madison Township, Richland County OH: Samuel ETZWILER age 35 OH, a plasterer; Emma age 21 OH; Amanda age 12 OH; Stephen age 9 OH; Alva age 8 OH; Maria age 4 OH; George age 1 OH.

1880 Census Madison Township, Richland County, OH: Samuel ETSWILER age 46 born OH, a plasterer, parents born PA; Emma, wife, age 31 OH, father born PA, mother MD; Martha A, dau, age 21 OH.

Hardesty's Richland = Hardesty's Historical and Geographical Encyclopedia. [Richland County OH version] 1885...original available at the Ohio Historical Society. There is also a version of the soldier's biographies extracted from the above Hardesty's that has been published by the Richland County Genealogical Society, 1998 called Richland County, Ohio Civil War Veterans. Hardesty's states that Samuel Etwiler of Co. I was wounded at the time of the capture of the City Belle, but was able to march to the prison. His weight while in prison went from 175 pounds down to 97 pounds. His parents were Peter and Sarah (Harner) Etwiler. He was born September 26, 1833. He married Emma Sutch in November, 1867. Children: George W. and Edna Gertrude. [He was previously married to Maria Arnold [died 1866] in May of 1858. Children: Amanda, Stephen, Henry, Maria.]

1900 Census, Dwelling 439, Family 459: Lawrence Twp, Lawrence Village, Van Buren, Michigan: Oscar W. WARD, age 28 IN; Gertrude, wife, age 28 OH; Iva D, daughter, age 10 OH; Andrew, son, age 2 OH; Warren, age months MI; Samuel ETSWILER, father, age 67 OH; Joseph O. COOK, age 80 NY, boarder.

Washington, Death Certificates, 1907-1960 at Family Search: Henry Samuel ETZWILER died 18 Oct 1908 at Everett, Snohomish Co Washington. Age 75 yrs, 22 dys. Born <1833>. Can't see original document.

Daughter, Death Record in Washington at Family Search: Edna Gertrude WARD died in Everett, Snohomish Co Washington pm 10 September 1929. Born <1871> Married to Oscar WARD. Father Samuel ETZWILER.

Daughter, Death Record in Ohio at Family Search: Martha Amanda HALL died 1 May 1920 at Mansfield, Richland Co OH. Address 282 E. 4th St. Age 61. Widowed. Born 29 Jun 1858 at Mansfield. Burial Mansfield Cemetery. Father Samuel ETZWILER born Mansfield, OH. Spouse H. L. HALL. Informant: Mrs. John MILLER, 282 ? 4th St.
