HANAVIOUS, David 15 Aug 1862 HANNAFUS
Private Hanavious was age 26 when he entered service.
Transferred to Co. K, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864.
Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865.[Hannarious]
Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Mother: Polly [usually a nickname for Mary] ????

Marriage: Elizabeth STONER on 5 Nov 1858 in Richland Co OH

1870 Census, Shelby Village, Sharon Township, Richland County OH, Dwelling 353, Family 346: David HONAVINS [HONAVIUS] age 33 PA, a blacksmith; Elizabeth C age 31 PA; Mary age 12 OH; William age 9 OH; Sarah A age 7 OH; George A age 3 OH; Silas F age 1 OH; James O. WOLF age 13 OH.

1880 Census, Shelby, Richland County, OH, Dwelling 174, Family 195 : D. HANAVIOUS age 42 PA, working in flour mill, parents born PA; Elizabeth, wife, age 40 PA, parents born PA; Silas F, son, age 12 OH; Liza, dau, age 7 OH; Florine, daughter, age 1 OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Shelby, Richland Co OH; Line 28, House 366: Daid HANAFIUS, Pvt, Co I 120th OVInf. Post Office: Shelby, Richland Co OH. Comments: transferred 120 to F 48th on 27 Nov 1864. Consolidated 114th 24 July 1865.

1900 Census, 18 Church Rd, Shelby, Sharon Twp, Richland County OH, Dwelling 241, Family 256: David HANNAFUS, age 63 PA, born Sept 1836, married 42 yrs, father born Germany, mother born PA, day laborer; Elizabeth, age 62 PA, born May 1838, married 42 yrs, 9 children, 7 still living, parents born PA, washer woman.

1910 Census, 18 Church St, Shelby, Sharon Twp, Richland County OH, Dwelling 245, Family 255: David HANAFUS, age 73 PA, first marriage, married 51 yrs, parents born PA, no occupation, column 30 for military service is marked yes; Elizabeth, wife, age 72 PA, first marriage, married 51 yrs, no children [????], parents born in PA, washerwoman for private family.

1920 Census, 18 Church St, Shelby, Sharon Twp, Richland County OH, Dwelling 11, Family 11: David HANNAFUS, age 83 PA, married, parents born PA, no occupation; Elizabeth, wife, age 81 PA, married, parents born PA, no occupation.

Richland [Ohio] Indigent Soldier Burials 1916-1922: David HANNAFUL, 120th OVI, blacksmith, died 28 May 1920, buried Shelby Cemetery.

Ohio Online Death Certificate Index: David HANAFUS, died 28 May 1920 in Richland County OH.

Spelled David HANAVIOUS at Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System.

Death Record in Ohio: File #38818, David HANAFUS died 28 May 1920 at 18 Church St, Shelby, Richland Co OH. Married. Blacksmith. Born 10 Sep 1835 at Lebanon PA. Burial Oakland Cem, Shelby OH. Informant S. F. HANAFUS of Shelby OH.
