KELSO, Washington* 9 Oct 1862

Private Kelso was age 18 when he entered service. Died 13 June 1863. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Memphis, Tennessee in the Mississippi River Cemetery in section 2, grave 158.

???1850 Census, Milton Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 33, Family 33: Samuel KELSO, age 50 PA, farmer; Mary, age 50 MD; Levina SUTTON, age 31 PA; Maryann SUTTON, age 7 PA; Washington SUTTON, age 5 PA; Sarah J. SUTTON, age 2 OH.

???1860 Census, Milton Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 225, Family 242: Samuel KELSEY, age 60 PA; Mary, age 59 PA; Washington, age 14 PA; John, age 4 PA; Lavina SUTTON, age 42 MD. [Note: So was this Washington a SUTTON or a KELSO?]

Lavina SUTTON was in Ashland County OH Poor House in 1870.
