LINDLY, Israel 22 Aug 1862 Israel LINDLEY
Private Lindly was age 29 when he entered service. Captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Pension Index: Israel LINDLY, I 120th: Invalid filed 1878 Mar 4. Widow Martha E. LINDLY applied for pension in Michigan on 6 Oct 1905. Pension Card: Israel died 1905.

Ohio County Marriages: Izrael LINDLY married Martha E. LINDSLEY on 26 Apr 1860 in Richland Co OH.

1880 Census Hamlin, Eaton County, MI, Dwelling 196, Family 210 : Israel LINDLEY age 46 OH, a farmer, father born OH, mother born PA; Martha, wife, age 37 PA, parents born PA; Dora E, dau, age 18 OH; Charles B, son, age 14 MI; Wesley L, son, age 8 MI.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Hamlin Twp, Eaton Co MI: Line 10, House 51, Family 53: Israel LINDLY, Pvt, Co I 120 OH Inf. Post Office Charlesworth, Eaton Co MI. Disability: Chronic diarrhoea. Comments: Prisoner at Andersonville, Libby and Bell Isl. [Note: according to the list I have from Camp Ford, Israel was captured and sent to Camp Ford, Texas. No evidence yet that he was in any other prison camp.]
