

Company I, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

MYERS, David* 20 Aug 1862

Private David Myers was age 45 when he entered service. Died 22 Feb 1863.

No burial information is given in the Roll of Honor.

Death: 22 Feb 1863 near Vicksburg, possibly at Young's Point.

Cemetery: Have not found. Is not listed at Vicksburg. [Possibly buried as unknown.]

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: David MYERS, Pvt, Co I 120 OH Inf, died 22 Feb 1863 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: phthisis pulm. [tuberculosis]

[3144] Widow Nancy M. PEARCE, soldier Cost J. PEARCE of Co I 98th OV. She died 7 Feby 1903. [Cost PEARCE is also spelled Cost PIERCE]

[3145] Guradians for soldier's minor children: Elias TOOKER and Soloman LEWIS, Mansfield OH, dated 4 Apr 1873.

[3154]Minor children of David Myers: Abraham, would turn age 16? on 17 July 1876; Stephen, would turn age 16? on 14 Aug 1878.

[3155] Nancy M. PEARCE of Cambridge (Guernsey Co) OH....widow of Cost J. PEARCE, Pvt Co I, 98th O. Vol died at Carrolton OH, 13 Aug 1879.

[3159] David and Mary were married at Ashland Co OH by Samuel Coulter, J.P. on 20 Apr 1856. David died 22 Feb 1863 near Vicksburg Miss. Mary remarried 14 Apr 1866 at Ashland Co OH.

[3161] Dated 7 Feb 1873: Mary Myers had since married Wm PLUMB.

[3173] William McILVAIN, Lieut Co I, 120th OVI: "company quarters then situated in a low damp unhealthy place at which time the said Myers was quite feeble and thin in flesh and said 'Lieut I am not long for this world' but affiant (McIlvain) did not then think said Myers would die so soon. Many others were sick at the same time."

[3174] George W. MYERS and Amos M. MYERS, ages 41 and 42 testified: David left no children surviving by either the first or second marriage except for James, Stephen and Abram. James was born 12 July 1849.

[3176] David MYERS married Lydia LOWRY, 30 July 1835, Wayne Co OH, by Justice of the Peace, John M. Hamilton.

[3177] David MYERS married Mary LEWIS, 20 Apr 1856, Ashland Co OH, by Samuel Culler, JP.

[3182] Lydia died 21 May 1853 in Richland County OH. Testified by A.M. and George W. Myers, of Madison Twp, Richland Co OH. [A M is Amos M.]

[3183] Lydia and David had son, James, born 12 July 1849 at their residence. Midwife's name was Sarah DIXON.

[3185] Sarah DICKSON was the midwife at the birth of Stephen, son of David and Mary MYERS, on 15 Aug 1862.

[3187] Elias Tooker was the guardian of Abraham Myers. Richland Co OH 1873.

[3189] Soloman Lewis was guardian of Stephen Myers. Richland Co. OH, 1873

[3191] Abraham Myers born 18 July 1860; Stephen Myers born 15 Aug 1862

[3191] Soldier died at Youngs Point, La, of Phthisis Pulmonalis [tuberculosis] Widow remarried 14 Apr 1866.
