MYERS, Hiram* 11 Oct 1862

Private Hiram Myers' age not given. Died 10 June 1863.

The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi, section H, grave 5.

Father: ?Jacob MYERS

Mother: ?Sarah McCARDAL

MYERS, Co I 120th OH, 10 Jun 1863, section H, site 5.] [Listed at Interment.net as Myers, Henry, d. 10 Jun 1863, Plot: H 5, Pvt, Civil War, Co I 120th OH] This is actually Hiram MYERS.

Relationship: ?brother of Henry MYERS of Co I 120th OVI

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: listed as Herman MYER, Pvt, Co I 120 OH Inf, died 10 June 1863 at Van Buren General Hospital, Millikens Bend LA. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Burial Registers, Military Plots and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960: Originally buried at grave yard at Marshall Plantation, Madison Parish, LA. running number 430. H. MYERS, Private, Co I 120th OH Inf, died 10 June 1863. Vicksburg section H 5.

National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962: H. MYERS, Co I 120 OH Reg. Died 10 June 1863, Vicksburg National Cemetery. Sec. H 5. Remarks: see case of J. ROSENBERGER, grave 1, sec. H. [*Register of Deaths: Joseph Rosenberger, Pvt, Co A 60th IN Vol. died 10 June 1863 at Van Buren, Milliken's Bend, LA. Cause: Cl*on?? dysentery. Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960: on same sheet as H. Myers: running number 434: Joseph ROSENBERGER, Pvt, Co A 60th IN V I. died July 11 1863....June 10 crossed out. Put in H 1 at Vicksburg. Originally at grave yard at Marshall Plantation, Madison Parish, LA. Vicksburg said that he was buried 10 June.*]

Have not found in Pension Index. And with an age not given in the roster, it makes ID more difficult to identify:

1850 Census, Weller Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 20, Family 20: Jacob MYRES, age 39 PA, farmer; Sarah, age 34 PA; Hiram, age 16 PA; John, age 15 PA; Jacob, age 14 PA; Amos, age 12 PA; George, age 10 PA; Henry, age 7 OH; David, age 6 OH; Emeline, age 4 OH; Sarah A, age 1 OH.

1860 Census, Weller Twp, Richland Co OH, page 320: Jacob MEIR, age 49 PA, farmer; Sarah, age 44 PA; Hiram, age 25 PA, farmer; Jacob, age 22 PA, farmer; Amos, age 21 PA, farmer; George, age 20 OH; Henry, age 18 OH; David, age 16 OH; Emiline, age 14 OH; Sarah A., age 10 OH.

1870 Census, Franklin Twp, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 52, Family 51: Jacob MYERS, age 59 PA, farmer; Sarah, age 53 PA; David, age 26 OH, farm laborer; Sarah, age 21 OH, no occupation.

???Brother's Ohio Death Record: David MEYERS, died 1 Nov 1926 at Franklin, Richland Co OH. Age 82y 7m 25d, estimated birth 1844. Father Jacob MEYERS. Mother Sarah McCARDAL. Spouse Mary MEYERS.
