O'KEEFE, Daniel, Jr.* 13 Aug 1862

Private Daniel O'Keefe, Jr. was age 24 when he entered service. Died 8 Oct 1863. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Chalmette, Louisiana, in Monument Cemetery.
