PALMER, Eli F.* 15 Aug 1862

Private Palmer was age 23 when he entered service. Died 21 July 1863. No burial information given in the Roll of Honor.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Eli F. PALMER, Pvt, Co I 120th OH Inf, died 22 July 1863 on the floating hospital "Nashville TN." Cause: intermittent febris.
