1850 Census, Pike, Knox Co OH, Dwelling 1390, Family 1435: Reubin Phillips, age 50 MD, farmer; Elizabeth, age 49 MD; William age 19 OH, farmer; Reubin, age 17 OH, farmer; Moses, age 15 OH, farmer; Charles, age 12 OH; Elmira, age 7 OH. [Several other Phillips families on that page.]

1860 Census, Pike Twp, Knox Co OH, Dwelling 288, Family 290: Ruben Philips, age 60 MD, farmer; Elizabeth, age 59 MD; Charles PHILIPS, age 21 MD, laborer.

1870 Census, Pike Twp, Knox Co OH, Dwelling 9, Family 9: Charles PHILLIPS, age 32 OH, farmer; Mary E, age 29 OH; Lilly B, age 6 OH; [next page] Kitty, age 3 OH; Reuben, age 70 MD, farmer; Elizabeth, age 69 MD.

Moved to Hardin County OH. **Not listed in the 1910 census as being in the Union Army in the Civil War.**
