STIVER, Abraham* 16 Oct 1862
Private Stiver was age 30 when he entered service. Died 31 Jan 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri.]
The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at St. Louis, Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery, section 65, grave 167.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Abraham STIVERS, Private, Co I 120th OH Inf, died 31 Jan 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks MO. Cause: consumption.

National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962: Abraham STIVERS, Co I 120 OH Inf. Died 31 Jan 1863. Originally buried at Christ Church Cemetery, St. Louis, MO. Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery, MO....Sec 65 Grave 10438.

Pension Index: Abraham STIVER, Co I 120th OH Inf. Widow Rebecca STIVER filed 28 Mar 1863, Application 16503, Certificate 5823.

Wife, Rebecca's family was in Perry Twp, Columbiana Co OH in 1850.

Not the right family. ???1850 Census, Young Twp, Jefferson Co, PA, Gottlob STIVER, age 27 PA, farmer; Caroline, age 28 PA; Catharine MESEBERG, age 16 PA; Abram STIVER, age 18 PA. [This Gottlieb Stiver had a son Abram born in <1862>.] Gottlieb moved later to IN. Gottlieb had a brother Abraham who died in 1896.

Columbiana County OH Probate marriage record: Abraham STIVER married Rebecca HARRIS 1 Feb 1855 in Columbiana County OH.

1860 Salem, Perry Township Columbiana County, OH, Dwelling 1195, Family 1176: Abram SHIVE age 28 PA, cigar maker; Rebecca age 28 PA; Wm H. age 3 OH; Elizabeth W age 1 OH.

1870 Salem, Perry Township, Columbiana County OH, Dwelling 242, Family 250: Nathan HARRIS age 81 born PA, no occupation given; Hannah age 72 PA; Rebecca STIVER age 38 PA; William STIVER age 13 OH. [Note: where was Alfred?]

1880 Census, Salem, Perry Twp, Columbiana Co OH, Dwelling 326, Family 347: Hannah HARRIS, age 81 PA, parents born PA; Rebecca STIVER, age 48? PA, daughter, parents born PA; William STIVER, age 23 OH, teamster, son, parents born PA; Alfred W. STIVER, age 19 OH, son, painter, parents born PA. [William and Alfred are the sons of Abraham and Rebecca STIVER.]

1900 Census, 1009 South St, Fremont, Sandusky Co OH, Dwelling 355, Family 375: Rebecca STIVER, mother in law, age 62 PA, born Jan 1832, single, parents born PA. She is living with the Charles and Elizabeth GRABEL family. [Ohio Marriages at Family Search: Elizabeth Anne STIVER married Arthur Charles GRABLE on 15 Jun 1883 at Columbiana Co OH.]

1910 Census, 1009 South St, Fremont, Sandusky Co OH, Dwelling 187, Family 198: Rebecca STIVER, mother in law, age 78 PA, widow, 3 children/3 still living, parents born in PA. She is living with the Arthur C and Elizabeth A GRABLE family.

Death record in Ohio : Rebecca STIVER died 27 Apr 1912 at Fremont, Sandusky Co OH, 1009 South St. Widow. Born 30 Jan 1832 PA. Father Nathan HARRIS born PA. Mother Hanah WRITE born PA. Informant A C GRABLE of 1009 South St, Fremont OH. Burial at Oakwood Cemetery.

Widow's Pension at fold3.com :

Abraham STIVER, I 120th OVI: widow Rebecca STIVER applied for pension 28 Mar 1863.

Minor children: William Howard born 24 May 1857, Elizabeth Anna born 7 Nov 1858, Alfred W. born 4 Dec 1860.

Abraham STIVER married Rebecca HARRIS on 1 Feb 1855 in Columbiana Co OH. Abraham died 31 Jan 1863 at Jefferson Barracks MO of lung fever. In 1863 Rebecca STIVER was age 31 and living in Salem, Columbiana Co OH. Abraham enrolled at Richland Co OH. Abraham STIVER married Rebecca HARRIS on 1 Feb 1855 at Columbiana Co OH. Rebecca died 27 Apr 1912.

VA Administration Pension Payment Card: Rebecca STIVER died 27 April 1912. Name next to date is B. A. FOUCHE, Fremont OH. That is probably who notified the bureau.
