

Company I, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

TAGGART, Martin V. 15 Aug 1862

Private Taggart was age 18 when he entered service. Captured 19 Jan 1863 near Gaines' Landing, Mississippi; also captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Marriage: Mary E. McCORMIC on 25 Oct 1868 in Richland County OH

M. V. TAGGART married Mary E. McCORMIC on 25 Oct 1868 in Richland County OH.

1900 Census Waulnut St, Grenola City, Greenfield Township, Elk County KS, Dwelling 19, Family 19: Martin V TAGGART age 56 born Apr 1844 in OH, married 30 yrs, a laborer and carpenter, father born OH, mother born PA; Mary E, wife, age 53 born May 1847 in OH, married 30 yrs, 3 children, 2 still living, father born OH, mother PA; Laila? A, dau, age 28 born Apr 1872 in OH, single; Myrta? F, dau, age 23 born Sep 1876 in OH, single.
