

Company I, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

WINEMILLER, Joseph* 11 Aug 1862

Private Winemiller was age 21 when he entered service. Died [of disease] 14 Jan 1863. No burial information given in the Roll of Honor.

Father: Jacob WINEMILLER

Mother: Barbara ROWLAND

Birth: 1841, Montgomery Twp, Ashland Co OH

Death: 14 Jan 1863 [Ancestry.com American Civil War Soldiers service record: Died of disease 14 Jan 1863, but doesn't say where.]

Illinois State Journal [Springfield]. Thursday. 22 Jan 1863, Pg 3, Column one: Cairo, Jan 20 - "The steamer Die Vernon arrived this morning with the sick from the Vicksburg expedition and the wounded from Arkansas Post. She had, when she started, 400 on board, in charge of Surgeon C. J. Daws, 44 having died on the way up; all but two from disease. The following were buried on the Arkansas river, a few miles above the mouth."

List included Jas. WINEMILLER, Co I 120th Ohio.

Cemetery: Originally buried on the Arkansas river, a few miles above the mouth. I have found no record that Winemiller's body was moved to a cemetery. Perhaps he was moved and buried as an "unknown."

Pension Index for Joseph WINEMILLER of the 120th.....has company E on the record...father Jacob WINEMILLER applied for pension 31 Mar 1883, Application 302743, no Certificate number. [Note: There is a Jacob WINEMILLER age 65 in Springfield Township, Richland County OH in 1880.] Pension Card: Also has Co E on the card. [Civil War Soldiers and Sailors lists him in Co I.]

Family Search: Joseph WINEMILLER was born in 1841 Montgomery Township, Ashland County OH. His parents were Jacob and Barbary [ROWLAND] WINNEMILLER. That birth year would correspond to his age at entering the service.

1850 Census, Montgomery Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 461, Family 473: Jacob WINEMILLER, age 36 MD, blacksmith; Barbara, age 34? PA; George, age 11 OH; Joseph, age 9 OH; Caroline, age 7 OH; Jacob, age 5 OH; John, age 2 OH.

1860 Census, Springfield Twp, Richland County, OH, Dwelling 1321, Family 1331: Jacob WENMILLER, age 45 PA, blacksmith; Barbara, age 42 PA; George, age 20 OH, laborer; Joseph, age 18 OH, laborer; Caroline, age 17 OH; Jacob, age 15 OH; John, age 12 OH; Elizbth, age 8 OH; Christopher, age 4 OH.

Parents: There is a Jacob Winemiller buried at Red Squirrel Cemetery, Richland Co OH. Died 27 July 1884, age 69 -4-20, which would account for the fact that he never got a certificate for the pension.
