WOODS, James H. 13 Aug 1862 James Harvey WOODS James Harbeson WOODS
Private Woods was age 19 when he entered service. Transferred to Co. K, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864.
Transferred to 88th Co, 2d Battalion, Veteran Reserve Corps, 27 Mar 1865. Detached at Medical Director's
office 5 Apr 1866. No further record found.

" He participated in the battles of Chickasaw Bayou and Arkansas Post and went down the Mississippi river to Young's Point, where he was in camp for a time. [next page] With his command he afterward crossed the river below Vicksburg and participated in the battle of Thompson Hill, while later he took part in the battles of Jackson and Black River and was also present at the siege of Vicksburg until its surrender. From the battle of Arkansas Post he served as a messenger on special duty until the close of the war, being connected with the staffs of General Henselman, General Joseph Hooker, and others. Although he was not wounded in battle he had met with an accident which, though seemingly slight, has since been felt. He started with a message on a dark night and, tripping on a rope, fell and hit a stake. The fall impaired his health and he feels the effects to this day."

[Are these the soldier's parents?: James Woods married Elizabeth Mary FIVECOAT on 12 Mar 1839 in Richland Co OH.]

Father second marriage??? James WOODS married Mary COOK, 14 April 1851 at Richland Co OH.

MAIN, age 39 OH, saddler; Mary E., age 29 OH; Effie C, age 10 OH; Minnie MANN, age 19 OH; Harvey WOODS, age 25 OH, clerk in store; John ROYER, age 23 OH, clerk in store; Allen MOFFETT, age 18 OH, photographer; Frank STEHL, age 54 Bavaria, hom-doctor [homeopathic?].

Ohio Marriage Record: J. H. WOODS married Emma A. BROWN on 15 May 1873 at Richland Co OH, by D. W. Smith, Minister of the Gospel.

1900 Census, 50 Glessner Ave, Mansfield Ward 1, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 215, Family 232: Harvey J. WOODS, age 55 OH, born Aug 1844, married 27 yrs, parents born OH, real estate ; Emily A. , wife, age 47 OH, born Sep 1852, married 27 yrs, one child/one still living, parents born PA.

1910 Census, 50 Glessner Ave., Mansfield Ward 1, Richland Co OH, Dwelling 28, Family 31: James H. WOODS, age 65 OH, first marriage, married 37 yrs, Rural mail carrier for the government, parents born US,

column 30 marked UA for military service; Emily A., wife, age 58? OH, first marriage, married 37 yrs, 0 children, parents born PA.

Death record in Ohio: James Harbeson WOODS died 20 Dec 1918 at Washington Twp, Richland Co OH. Born 16 Aug 1843 in OH. Married. Retired. Burial Mansfield, OH. Father James WOODS, born PA. Mother born PA.

Wife's death record in Ohio: Emily Ann WOODS died 20 Dec 1918 at Washington Twp, Richland Co OH. Born 10 Sep 1853 at Medina Co OH. Widowed. House Wife. Burial Mansfield OH. Father Jacob R. BROWN, born PA. Mother Margaretta BOWDEN, born PA. [Find a Grave has her death date as 26 December 1918]
