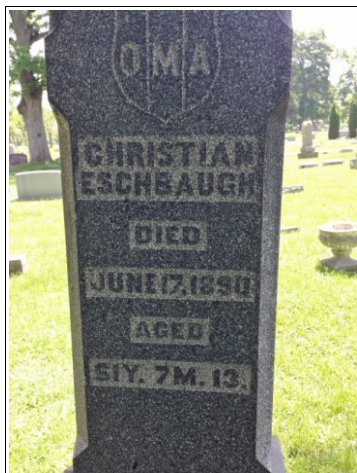

ESCHBAUGH, Christian 8 Oct 1862
Private Eschbaugh was age 34 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

"A pension has been granted Christian Eschbaugh, night clerk of the European, and he will be listed for the same from October, 1882." Richland Shield and Banner 25 June 1887, Vol. LXX, No. 5 [The [Court European Hotel](#) was on the west side of Main St in Mansfield.]
