

## Company K, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

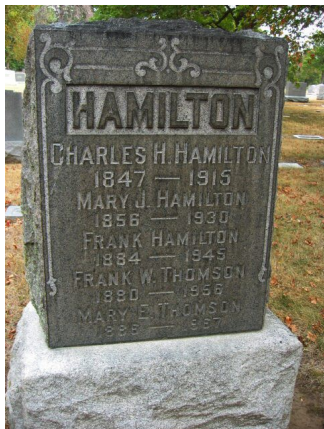

Charles H. HAMILTON, **alias James B. WILSON**

Private Wilson was age 18 when he entered service. Transferred to Co. K, 114th OVI, 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co D, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 9 May 1866.

Father: Elijah? HAMILTON

Mother: ???? DOUGLASS

Birth: 18 Oct 1847 OH

Marriage: Mary J. MACKEY

[may have been other marriages]

Death: 5 or 15 Feb 1915, Kansas City MO

Cemetery: Forest Hill Cemetery, Kansas City MO, Block 46

Pension Card: James B. WILSON alias Charles H HAMILTON, Co K 120th OH Inf., Co D 48th OH Inf., Co K 114th OH Inf., Co I 4th US Cav. Invalid applied 23 Apr 1900 and 27 Oct 1909, Application 1247351, Certificate 1126149. Widow applied 5 Mar 1915, Application 1042877, Certificate 795262. Contesting widow applied 9 Dec 1921, Application 1183141, no Certificate. Contesting widow applied 21 Nov 1916, Application 1083403, no Certificate. James died 15 Feb 1915 at Kansas City MO.

Family Search, Veterans Administration Pension Payment Cards, 1907-1933: Soldier Charles H HAMILTON alias James B WILSON, Pvt Co K 120 and D 48 OH Inf. Mary J's address in Aug 1930 was 3219 Lockridge Ave, Kansas City MO. Widow Mary J. HAMILTON, 795262, died 21 Sep 1930.

1850-1880 Census records: Maybe with the pension papers this mystery could be solved.

Wikipedia says this about the [4th US Cavalry](#): "...mid-19th century. It was one of the most effective units of the Army against Indians on the Texas frontier." "The [4th United States Cavalry Regiment](#) was established as part of the expansion of mounted U.S. Army units in the mid-1850s. It was officially organized on 26 March 1855, at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri, as the U.S. 1st Cavalry Regiment. As the 1st Cavalry Regiment was the fourth oldest mounted regiment in terms of active service, it was re-designated as the 4th United States Cavalry Regiment on 3 August 1861." [No indication of military service.]

1920 Census, 2420 Denver Ave, Kansas City Ward 14, Jackson Co MO, Dwelling 129, Family 136: Mary J. HAMILTON, age 64 IL, widow, parents born Ireland; Frank, son, age 35 KS, single, father born OH, mother born IL, couil? traveler for refining company.
