HUGHES, Jacob 8 Oct 1862

Private Hughes was age 40 when he entered service. He was discharged on 3 June 1864 at Morganzia, Louisiana, on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Ohio, Marriages, 1800-1958: Jacob HUGHES married Sarah ANDREWS, 5 Nov 1840 at Hanover Twp, Richland Co OH.

1860 Census, Cardington Village, Morrow Co OH, Dwelling 763, Family 749: Jacob HUGHES, age 30 PA, blacksmith; Sarah, age 36 OH; Tabitha, age 15 OH; Margaret, age 7 OH; Columbus, age 5 OH; Delano, age 3 OH.

1870 Census, Ridott, Stephenson Co, IL, Dwelling 13, Family 12: Jacob HUGHES, age 52 PA, hotel keeper; Sarah, age 48 OH; Columbus, age 14 OH; Delano, age 12 OH.

1880 Census, Pecatonica, Winnebago, IL, Dwelling 396, Family 406: Jacob HUGHES, age 61 PA, blacksmith, father born Wales, mother born (Germany); Sarah, age 58 OH, father born OH; mother born Ireland; Franklin C., age 25 OH, son, single, works in saw mill; Adelbert, age 22 OH, single, son, works on farm; Jacob SYMES, age 9 IL, grandson, father born NY, mother born OH.

Family Search, Iowa, Marriages, 1809-1992: Jacob HUGHES married Margaret FERGUSON, 5 Aug 1888 at Clinton Co IA.

Did not find in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

Iowa, State Census, 1895: Jacob HUGHES, age 75 PA <1820>, residence Davenport, Scott Co IA.

Jacob died 1898 in IA.

The Davenport Daily Leader; Tuesday, April 12, 1898:

Jacob Hughes died last night at 6:30 o'clock at the residence, 1508 Brady street. Mr. Hughes had attained the great old age of 84 years. He leaves a wife and three children, two sons and one daughter. Mr. Hughes was a veteran of the Civil war, having served three years, being a member of the 120th Regiment of Ohio Infantry Volunteers. He was a highly esteemed citizen and his death will occasion general sorrow. The funeral will take place Wednesday at 2 p. m. from the residence, with interment in Oakdale cemetery.

Widow Margaret had been married twice before to veterans.

Widow's pension: Margaret E. Hughes, 23 May 1898, Application 676762, Certificate 474896, Iowa. Pension Card: Jacob died 11 Apr 1898 at Davenport IA. Note indicates John FERGUSON Co F 12th IL Inf. So the widow was also married to FERGUSON, 553749. Note also indicates George W. TERRY Co H 59th NY Inf. So the widow may have married twice after Jacob died.

John FERGUSON, residence Galena [Jo Daviess County] IL, 3 Aug 1861, discharged term expired. The regiment mustered out 18 July 1865.

Pvt George W. TERRY enlisted 1 Sept 1861 at age 39 at Belleville, [Richland Co], OH. Company H was recruited in Ohio.
