HYMAN, John H. 27 Feb 1864

Private Hyman was age 26 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana; discharged 14 July 1864 at Barracks Hospital, New Orleans, Louisiana, on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

[A History of the Pioneer and Modern Times of Ashland County, Ohio - H. S. Knapp 1863] This book also lists John HYMAN as a Private in Co B, 16th Regiment of the Ohio Volunteer Militia. In the Official Roster of the Soldiers of the State of Ohio he is listed as joining on 23 April 1861, age 23, for 3 months service, and he mustered out with the company on 18 Aug 1861.

Company B enrolled at Ashland. The Regiment was named Carrington Guards in honor of Adjutant-General Carrington. The Regiment served in West Virginia, at Phillippi, Laurel Hill, and Carrick's Ford.

Ashland County Marriages by Nellie M Raber: John H HYMAN married Mary E GRIFFITH on 3 Feb 1858 in Ashland County, OH.

1860 Census, Clear Creek, Ashland County, OH, page 165: John HIMON, age 22 PA, laborer; Mary E, age 21 PA; Emma J, age 1 OH.

John was missing from this census: 1870 Census, Clear Creek, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 175, Family 166: Mary HYMAN, age 32 PA; Emma J., age 11 OH; Cora C, age 8 OH; Johnathan, age 6 OH.

1880 Census, Savannah, district 79, Ashland County, OH, page 13.4000: John HYMAN, age 41 PA, farming, parents born PA; Mary E, wife, age 40 PA, parents born PA; Adelbert J, son, age 16 OH, farm hand.

[Old Keys, Historical sketch of Clear Creek Twp, Ashland Co OH and Savannah, by Rae Bailey, 1941 ..... "The following September (1887), a lot was purchased of John Hyman, for the sum of twenty-five dollars. Hyman at that time owned and occupied the cottage on Main Street, just across the alley south of the present Community Hall (now the home of the Clarence J. Loyd family).]"

Wife Mary E. died 1893, buried [Savannah Cemetery](#), Ashland Co OH.

Ohio marriage: John HYMAN married Lottie CASE on 7 Mar 1894 at Ashland Co, OH.
