JOHNSON, Milford 28 Sept 1862 JOHNSTON Private Johnson was age 30 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.
