KERR, Thomas* 9 Oct 1862

Private Thomas Kerr was age 23 when he entered service. He died 14 Feb 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri.

The Roll of Honor lists his burial at St. Louis, Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery in section 65, grave 161 [old numbering system].

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Thomas KERR, Private, Co K 120th OH Inf, died 3 Feb 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks, MO. Cause: typhoid fever.

U.S. National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962: Thomas KERR, Co K 120th OH reg. died 2 Feb 1863. Originally buried at Christ Church Cemetery St. Louis, MO. Jefferson Barracks MO cemetery, Section 65, grave 10434.

Can not find in Pension index.
