Loutham LOUTHAN, Henry H. 15 Oct 1862 LOUTHAN aka H. W. LAUBHER  
Private Loutham was age 18 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Every one enjoyed a fine time, and at a late hour departed, wishing Mr. Louthan many happy returns of the day.**

Disabilities when admitted to Home: cataracts both eyes and prolapse. Born Ohio, Age 64, height 5'8.5", light complexion, blue eyes, red hair, can read and write, Protestant, farmer, residence Oakland, KS, single, nearest relative: Mrs. F. E. BROWN of Oakland KS. Died 22 Feb 1921 in hospital. Body shipped to Mrs. F. E. BROWN, 1223 Monroe St., Topeka KS.
