McCLURE, James L. 24 Sept 1862

Sergeant McClure was age 20 when he entered service. He was wounded 11 Jan 1863 in the battle of Arkansas Post, Arkansas; transferred to Co. K, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Mother: Elizabeth LAYLANDER

Death: 10 Aug 1914 National Military Home, KS

Cemetery: National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers at KS

Pension index: Sergt. James L McCLURE, K 120th OH Inf, C 16th OH Inf, F 48th OH Inf and K 114th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1869 July 28 and 23 Feb 1907,

Application 146311, Certificate 103436, but the state was not given. Pension Card: James died 10 Aug 1914 National Military Home, KS.

Parents: Ohio Marriages: John McCLURE married Elisabeth LAYLANDER on 1 Apr 1841 at Holmes, Co OH.

1860 census Ripley township, Holmes county, OH, Dwelling 1188, Family 1212: John McCLURE age 48 born VA a farmer; Elizabeth age 38 in OH; James age 18 a farmhand; Andrew age 16 a farmhand; Robert age 13; Mary ? age 5. The children were all born in OH.

1870 Census, have not found.

1880 Census, Falls Twp, Chase Co, KS, Dwelling 188, Family 189: John McCLURE, age 63/68 OH [written over Penn], farmer, parents born PA; E. L, wife, age 57 OH, parents born PA; James, son, single, age 37 OH, farmer father born PA, mother born OH. Mary J, daughter, age 23 OH, housekeeper, parents born OH; Gila, granddaughter, age 5 OH, parents born OH.

Father, John, died 1890, buried [Maplewood Memorial Lawn Cemetery](#), Emporia, Lyon Co KS. Mother, Elizabeth, same cemetery, died 1893.

Not in the 1890 Special Veterans Schedule.

1895 [1 Mar] Kansas State Census: Emporia, Lyon Co KS, Line 32: James L. McCLURE, born abt 1842, age 53, born OH, came to KS from OH, farmer, was in Co K, 120th OH Inf.

1900 Census, have not found.

1905, Kansas State Census, Emporia, Lyon Co KS, 1 Mar 1905, Line 16. James L. McCLURE, age 63. Born OH. Came to KS from OH. Co C, 16th OH Inf.

Record at National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, Leavenworth County, KS: #15468 James L. McCLURE: Enlisted 23 Apr 1861 at Wooster, OH, Co C 16th OH Inf., Pvt., discharged 18 Aug 1891 at Columbus; Enlisted 24 Sep 1864 at Mansfield, Pvt, in Co K 120th OH Inf., discharged at Houston TX 27 Nov 1864 and transferred to Co F 48th OH Inf. as a Sgt. discharged 14 Oct 1865 at Houston TX. Born OH, age 63, height 5'7", dark complexion, hazel eyes, brown hair, can read and write, Protestant, occupation farmer, residence subsequent to discharge was Emporia [Lyon Co] KS, single. Nephew, Robert C. McCLURE, Millersburg, Holmes Co OH.

Admitted 14 June 1905. Died 10 Aug 1914, myocardial degeneration. Died at hospital at 4:10 pm. Location of Grave: Sec 23, Row 8, Grave 4937. Funeral at 9 am 12 Aug 1914. Rev. James M. PAYNE, chaplain. Niece notified at Mill Creek, OK.

1910 Census, National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, Delaware Twp, Leavenworth County, KS, page 51: James L McClure, age 68 single, born OH, father born PA, mother born OH, retired farmer. Marked UA for Union Army.
