RISSER, Isaac* 13 Oct 1862

Private Risser was age 18 when he entered service. He died 11 Feb 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri. The Roll of Honor lists his burial at St. Louis, Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery section 64, grave 132.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Isaac RICER, Co K 120th OH Inf, died 29 Jan 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks, MO. Cause: consumption.

Pension Card: Isaac REISER, Co K 120th OH Inf. Mother, Christine REISER, applied 2 Oct 1890, Application 449388, Certificate 314198, filed in MI. Isaac died 29 Jan 1863.
