SNYDER, Joseph 29 Sept 1862

Private Snyder was age 19 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio. [Also Co G 19th IN Inf.]

Joseph died 17 Feb 1905. Notes for Widow of Wesley DULL [first husband] Co K 82nd OH Inf. and Vincent T. TRAGO [second husband], Cos H. J. and K. 15th OH Inf. So the widow must have had at least two other husbands. [Family Search, Ohio, Marriages, 1800-1958: 1. V. T. TRAGO married Mary E. DULL, 5 May 1870 at Crawford Co OH. 2. Westley DOLL married Mary McKEAN on 6 May 1865 at Crawford Co OH.]

1900 Census, Black Fork Street, Shelby Village, Sharon Twp, Richland County, OH, pag 128: Joseph SNYDER, age 56 OH, born Dec 1843, married 8 yrs, painter, parents born PA; Mary E, wife, age 56 OH, born Nov 1843, married 8 yrs, 5 children, 4 still living, no birthplace for parents given.

Son's Death Record: File #35932, William E. SNYDER died 22 July 1912 in Lima, Allen Co OH. Single. Trainman. Born 24 Jan 1868 in OH. Parents, Joseph SNYDER and Sarah LAMER, born America. Burial Shelby OH. Informant Fred SNYDER, 219 E. Elm.

Son's Death Record: File #61657, Fred C. SNYDER, of 538 E. Vine ST., died 2 Nov 1938 at Memorial Hospital, Lima, Allen Co OH. Widowed. Retired B & O RR conductor. Born Nov 1870 at Shelby, OH. Parents, Joseph SNYDER and Sarah LAMER, born OH. Burial Woodlawn Cem. Informant, Earl RATE?, 538 E. Vine ???.
