Hospital Steward John H. GARBER entered service on 3 Sept 1862 at age 21. He was discharged 15 Feb 1863 on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Also listed as John H. GERBER. May also have been in 9th OH Inf 1861 for 3 months

Father: Christian Garver

Mother: Maria

Born: <1842> OH

Marriage: Probably not

Death 7 May 1863, probably at home in Wayne Co.

Cemetery: Westlawn Cemetery, Mt. Eaton, Paint Twp, Wayne Co OH.

Not on Pension Index.

John H. GERBER, son of C and M GERBER died 7 May 1863, age 21 yrs, 5 m 2dys

[Ohio Obit Index: John H. GERBER, Born <1842> Co C 102nd OVI Son of C and M. Died 1863. West Lawn Cem, Mt Eaton. But he isn't listed in Co A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, K, UNASSIGNED, or FIELD AND STAFF of the 102nd. **And he is not listed in the 102nd OVI at Soldiers and Sailors System. I think a mistake was made along the line in doing the [Wayne County Registration Cards](#), probably years ago.]**

1850 Census, Paint Twp, Wayne Co, OH, Dwelling 23, Family 24: Christ GARBER, age 46 Switzerland, farmer; Maria, age 36 Switzerland; Peter, age 18 Switzerland, farmer; **John, age 8 OH**; Elisabeth, age 6 OH; Frederick, age 4 OH; Louisa, age 2 OH.

1860 Census, Paint Twp, Wayne Co, OH, Dwelling 328, Family 329: Christian GARVER, age 56 Switzerland, farmer; Mary Ann, age 41 Switzerland; Elizabeth, age 17 OH; Frederick, age 14 OH; Louisa, age 12 OH; Mary, age 9 OH; Margaret, age 6 OH; Daniel, age 4 OH; Emma, age 1 OH. [Note: John may have been living with another family in 1860.]

The family was still living in Paint Twp in 1870 with the addition of Ellen, age 9.
