Commissary Sergeant William W. REINOEHL entered service 30 Aug 1862 at age 22. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 8 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Also listed as Sergeant in Co D 114th OH Inf.

1870 Census, Fairfield, De Kalb, IN, Dwelling, Family: Jacob REINOEHL, age 54 PA, farmer; Sarah E, age 53 PA; Abraham, age 21 OH, school teacher. [Note: Henry and family are living in the next dwelling.]
