Surgeon Byron STANTON entered service 26 Dec 1862. [age not given] He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; was transferred to 114th OVI 27 Nov, 1864.

Times-Picayune (New Orleans, La), Sunday Sep 3, 1865, pg 9 The Army and Navy:

Surgeon Wynkoop, U. S. A., takes charge of Harper General Hospital, Detroit, relieving Dr. Byron Stanton, formerly Surgeon to the 120th O. V. I., who has been appointed Superintendent of the Northern Ohio Lunatic Asylum for the ensuing six years. [[That asylum later became known as Cleveland State Hospital and closed in 1975 when it became the Cleveland Development Center.](#)]

Ohio Death Record: Dr. Byron STANTON died at Cincinnati, Hamilton Co OH, on 22 Dec 1923. His residence was 6248 Savannah St. He was widowed. Husband of Harriet Brown STANTON. He was born 14 Aug 1834 at Salem, Ohio. His father was Benjamin STANTON, born NC. His mother was Martha TOWNSEND. Informant was Geo. Cooper of Hamilton, OH. Burial at Spring Grove.

"Cincinnati. Dec. 22. --Dr. Byron Stanton, 89, health officer of Cincinnati and former commander of Ohio commandery of the Loyal Legion, died today at his home in College Hill."
