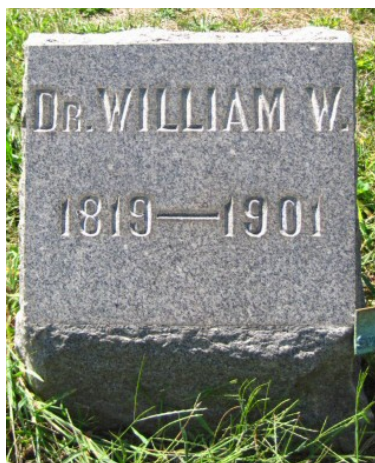
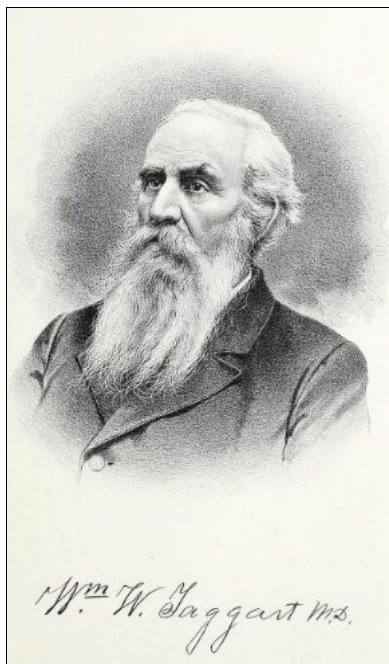

Surgeon William W. **TAGGART** entered service 4 Sept 1862 at age 43. He resigned 13 Nov 1862.

This William TAGGART died in 1901 in Wayne county OH according to the Wayne County Registrations Card found at <http://index.rbhayes.org/hayes/index/>

Father: Isaac TAGGART

Mother: Margaret McCaughey

Birth: 1819 Belmont Co OH

Marriage: Margaret McCoy, 1 June 1843 at Belmont Co OH

Death: May 1901, Wayne Co OH [Ohio Obit Index]

History of Wayne County, Ohio, Volume 1, by B. F. Bowen, 1910 page 560: There is an account of Judge Frank TAGGART. He was the son of Dr. W. W. TAGGART and Margaret McCAUGHEY. They came to Wayne Co near Smithville from Belmont co OH. They moved to a farm 1.5 miles northeast of Wooster. William's son Frank studied at College of Wooster and then became a lawyer. Williams's son Rush became a lawyer in NY City.

Ancestry.com William TAGGART married Margaret McCAUGHEY, 1 June 1843 at Belmont Co OH. See also daughter Clementine's death record below for verification.

History of the Lawyers of Wayne County, Ohio, from 1812 to 1900, by Benjamin Douglas, Clapper Printing Co, 1900. Page 80 Section about son Frank there was this information:

Dr. W. W. Taggart "came to Wayne County, in 1840, from Belmont County, Ohio, settled in the village of Smithville and at once entered upon the practice of his profession, in which he acquired a large and lucrative practice and attained to conceded eminence in the various branches of it. He is a man of strong, logical and discriminating mind a scholar in his profession....." In about 1857...."he removed to a farm he had purchased about one and one-half miles northeast of Wooster....."

1850 Census, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 83, Family 83: W. W. TAGGERT, age 31 OH, physician; Margaret, age 32 OH; Clementine, age 2 OH; Wm Rush, age 11 months OH.

This page on the census is impossible to read but this is Ancestry.com's interpretation. The last name was given a FIGERT but we know from history that Taggart lived in/near Smithville.

1860 Census, Green Twp, Wayne Co OH: William TAGGART, age 40 OH; Margaret, age 41 OH; Clementina, age 12 OH; William, age 10 OH; Frank, age 8 OH; Margaret, age 6 OH; Henrietta McCOY, age 21 OH.

1870 Census, Wooster City, Second Ward, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 39, Family 34: William TAGGART, age 50 OH, alaphathic physician; Margaret, age 52 OH; **Clementine**, age 22 OH; William R, age 21 OH, student Wooster University; Frank, age 18 OH, student Wooster University; Margaret, age 16 OH, high school.

1880 Census, Wooster, Wayne Co OH, Bowman St, Dwelling 585, Family 618: William W. TAGGART, age 60 OH, medical doctor, parents born PA; Margaret, wife, age 63 OH, father born Ireland, mother born PA; Clementine, daughter, age 32 OH; Frank, son, age 28 OH, lawyer; Maggie, daughter, age 26 OH, school teacher; James GILDERSLEEVE, boarder, age 19 IL, student U of W [University of Wooster], father born NY, mother born OH; Ettie McCOY, niece, age 41 OH, school teacher, parents born OH; Laura FOLLIS, servant, black, age 18 VA, parents born VA.

1890 Special Schedule for Veterans: Line 24, Dwelling 125, Family 129: TAGGART, Wm W., Surgeon 120th OH Inf. Disability: Gravels...Resigned on that account, Nov 13/'62. [*Pathology* The sand-like granular material of urinary calculi. [The Free Dictionary](#) In other words, kidney stones.]

1900 Census, Wooster City, Wayne Co OH, 97 East Bowman St, Dwelling 135, Family 157: William W. TAGGART, age 80 OH, widowed, born Aug 1819, parents born PA, landlord; Clementine, daughter, age 52 OH, single, parents born OH, born Dec 1847.

page 177 "In the spring of 1843 he commenced practice [medicine] at Vienna, Harrison Co., Ohio, but, not liking the place, he came to Wayne County in June, same year, locating at Smithville."

married Margaret McCoy, daughter of William and Jane McCoy, native of Stark Co OH, born Mar 1817, on 1 June 1843.

"In 1860 he bought a farm some two miles east of Wooster, on which he resided eight years, still practicing his profession, and in 1868 he moved finally to the city of Wooster, where he has since made his home."

Children: William Rush, Frank, Clementine, Margaret Greenslade.

"During the War of the Rebellion the Doctor was in the Government service as examining surgeon for the first draft. In 1862 he became surgeon of the One Hundred and Twentieth Ohio Volunteer Infantry, but, his health failing he was compelled to return to Wooster, where for a time he was assistant examiner in the marshal's office."
