VAN OSTERN, William V. 19 Aug 1862 William Vance VANOSTERN

1st Lieutenant Van Ostern was age 40 when he entered service. He was promoted to 2d Lieutenant from Sergeant on 15 Mar 1863; to 1st Lieut. 8 Sept 1863; appointed Regt. Quartermaster 6 Feb 1864; transferred from Regt. Quartermaster 12 Oct 1864; mustered out 27 Nov 1864 by reason of consolidation. See also [Field and Staff](#)

The National Tribune, 30 Jan 1908, page 7:

"Mustered Out

Van Ostern.--At Mount Eaton, O., Nov. 21, W. V. Van Ostern. Comrade Van Ostern was born in 1820 near Wooster, O., and enlisted in Co. A, 120th Ohio, and became First Lieutenant and Quartermaster of his regiment. When the regiment was consolidated he entered the 186th Ohio, and served to the close of the war. He had previously served in the 3d Ohio in the Mexican War."

They are the brother-in-law and sister-in-law of the head of household, John W NIMMONS, and wife Rebecca and are living with their family.
